You can now create posts with multiple images in Catholic Social Media. This allows parishes, schools, and organizations to share photo sets and visual updates in one post.

Creating a Multi-Image Post

- Click Create Post from the dashboard or Calendar view.
- Drag and drop your images into the upload box, or click the box to browse and select files.
- To add multiple images at once, hold **Shift** while selecting files.
- 1. Hover over an image and click the trash icon to remove it.

 2. Upload up to:

 a. 10 images for F • You can also add images one at a time by repeating the upload process.

- - b. 4 images for Twitter (if connected)
- 3. Once your images are set, write your caption, select platforms, and schedule the post as usual.

Best Practices

- Use a **consistent style** or **theme** across all images in a post for a professional look.
- Place your most important image first, as it will be the primary preview.
- Keep file sizes reasonable to avoid long upload times.
- Use multi-image posts to tell a story, show event highlights, or share step-by-step visuals.
